Bursary Program Guide

Program Overview & Application Guidelines

The Windsor Minor Hockey Association (WMHA) Bursary provides \$1,500 of financial assistance to a WMHA member annually to help offset the cost of post-secondary education. Students who have achieved a 75% average or better and have demonstrated a dedicated work ethic and have leadership and concern for others through voluntary activities and community involvement will be given serious consideration for this bursary.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to receive a WMHA Bursary, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

- ☐ Be registered with the WMHA for four of the last 5 years as a member in good standing;
- ☐ Have graduated or will graduate from high school during the current academic year;
- ☐ Must be enrolled or enrolling for admission as a full-time student at the University of Windsor or St. Clair College;
- ☐ Maintain a high standard of academic excellence;
- ☐ One application per household or family.

HOW TO APPLY

1. All candidates must complete the application form included in this guide;
2. Accompanying the application form, a candidate must submit all required documents.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ☐ A one page signed letter from the candidate outlining his/her contributions to hockey, what the game of hockey has meant to him/her and other information such as volunteer and community involvements;
- ☐ Two letters of reference; one from a high school teacher, counselor or administrator on official school letterhead; the other from an individual in the community (not a teacher or relative);
- ☐ Most current copy of his/her Official School Transcript;
- ☐ Copy of his/her current marks summary;
- ☐ Proof of enrollment (official document from the Registrar).

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

All required information must be received by the WMHA no later than July 31st, of the current academic year. Applications are to be sent to the following address:

The WMHA will announce successful applicants no later than September of the current academic year, upon receiving proof of enrollment via official document from the registrar. Payment will be made directly to the recipient.
