Discussion Points

1. Defining the processes required for each association following a vote in favour of the merger. Including a review of the articles of incorporation and updating as needed.
2. Defining the desired organization formation for the new association, complete with an identification of financial obligations of the existing organizations.
3. Creating an overview of the existing financial state and policies to identify the similarities and differences.
4. Creating a potential one year “transitional” structure of the board of directors for the new association. With equal representation between the two current associations.
