

How far will the teams travel for regular season games?	Travel is expected to be limited to just past London, roughly 2.5-3 hours
Will there be weeknight games?	It's highly unlikely there will be weeknight games
Will WMHA also have A teams?	No. OMHA has mandated that our second entry teams will remain at B (U11, U13, U15, U16, U18). B teams will continue to play in Bluewater
Why are there only B teams in every other age level?	OMHA does not have availability of B at every age group, only the divisional level. This has not changed from previous years
Will WMHA also host AAA?	No. Sun County and Windsor AAA Zone will continue to host AAA teams.
Who will Windsor AA Play?	Currently there are three other centers confirmed in the OMHA league, however, we are waiting for OMHA to finalize and confirm the league structure.
Will Windsor play against Alliance AA teams?	Interlock with Alliance AA is being discussed at the OMHA/Alliance levels. We intend to at minimum, play exhibition games vs some of the AA Alliance teams such as Sarnia, London, Cambridge, Waterloo, Woodstock and others.
Are there still open borders for AA?	Yes. There are no residential borders or restrictions for AA
When will tryouts be?	Tryouts will be in the spring, in the week in between AAA and A tryouts.
Do players have to try out for AA to try out for other centers A teams or WMHA B teams?	No. Players are free to try out for any team they want
Will WMHA mandate a certain number of WMHA players on each AA team?	No. Teams will be composed of the best players available.
Will independent evaluators still be used for tryouts?	Yes. WMHA plans to use independent evaluators to aid in player selection
Will AA teams be allowed to play more tournaments?	Yes, OMHA has agreed to allow additional tournaments if the teams choose to. Showcase weekends are also being discussed to have a number of teams all meeting in the same area to play multiple games the same weekend to reduce travel.
Where are AA Tournaments?	AA tournaments are in the same locations as A tournaments. Many host both divisions

Will the league be run by Bluewater?	No. The league will be run by OMHA
Could this be grandfathered and start only at the younger ages?	No. OMHA enforces centers to host teams all of the same category at all ages
Where will AP players come from?	We do not yet have this answer from OMHA
How many regular season games will there be?	We do not have a season structure from OMHA yet.
Will travel team fees go up?	Fees, as always, are a product of the cost of running the team. If icetime increases (longer practices for example) that affects team fees.
How will this affect house league?	There will be no changes to WMHA house league programming
Will WMHA still host Select?	Yes, we don't anticipate any changes to any programming other than AA/A
Is WMHA making this change as a money grab?	WMHA is a not-for-profit organization. We will run the AA teams as we currently run the A teams. We only recover the costs associated with running the teams, there is no profit built in.
Will Coaches be paid?	Rep Coaches will receive a monetary stipend, as they usually do. Amount TBD.
How is this different from when Lasalle stayed A?	Open borders allows all players to try out and OMHA has created a league to play in. Lasalle did not have a league and played A teams all year with residential restrictions restricting roster composition.
