

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) made an announcement earlier this year that will reshape the landscape of minor hockey in the province. Beginning in the 2025/26 season, the OHF will eliminate residential borders for players competing at the U10 level and above across all representative categories, including AAA, AA, A, and B. This significant change applies to both OMHA and Alliance programs, presenting exciting new opportunities for young athletes.
